# Develop essential skills for school with Plumtree's fun and practical school readiness program

The groups will focus on developing the following school readiness skills:

- Listening and speaking: Building communication skills.
- Following instructions and answering questions: Enhancing comprehension and response.
- Pre-literacy skills: Including rhyming and lettersound awareness.
- Fine motor skills: Improving pencil grip, drawing, writing, and cutting.
- Problem-solving and independence:
  Encouraging self-reliance and critical thinking.
- Social skills: Making friends, initiating conversations, turn-taking, and managing emotions.
- Attention and concentration: Increasing focus during tasks.
- Family involvement: We'll provide you with suggestions and ideas to continue supporting your child's skill development at home.
