This summer holidays, encourage your child to express themselves with PhotoVoice... and have fun!

What activities do young children with disability or developmental delay enjoy at the library or in their community? Let them show you with their photos!

Some children are better at expressing their likes or dislikes through images instead of words. In this two-part workshop, learn to use PhotoVoice: an activity where you encourage your child to take photos of activities and places they enjoy, or do not like and find challenging.

PhotoVoice is fun and promotes engagement with your child. The images are uploaded to inform community organisations or businesses about enhancing accessibility and inclusion. Your personal details remain confidential.

We're especially excited to learn how children experience their local library.

Families who've participated in PhotoVoice say it helped their children become more confident in expressing themselves and making their own choices.
