


Nature Play

Nature Playgroup is all about connecting with nature, having fun outdoors, and learning through play alongside others. Karen and Cathy, Occupational Therapists, will support the development of these skills. Each day in the bush is different.

Learning outcomes could include:

- Fostering your child's independence as they discover how to engage with the environment and develop essential self-help skills.
- Fostering connections among peers as they engage in group activities and outdoor adventures allows for shared experiences and opportunities for new friendships.
- Learning and exploring through adventure, guided by the weather and the ever-changing natural surroundings. Throughout the group's duration, participants will have an opportunity to suggest and review activities they'd like to explore together.

Activities may include:

- · making mud pies,
- · building with natural materials,
- slowing down to investigate & enjoy small wonders,
- climbing rocks, nature art & craft,
- learning about textures
